A search committee has been established to recommend to the Board of Governors a new Deputy Vice Chancellor and Principal (DVC) for the Okanagan campus. It held its first meeting on August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

The DVC, responsible to the President, will provide strategic leadership to UBC's Okanagan Campus to accomplish the vision, commitments, goals, and actions as set out in the University's strategic plan, *Place and Promise: The UBC Plan.* 

The DVC will provide high level oversight for a complicated portfolio focusing on the operation of the Okanagan campus and its relationship with the UBC system.
